# 1. Program Overview

### 1.1. Objectives

- To strengthen R&D collaboration networks and develop future-oriented joint research projects by supporting organizations of workshops/seminars and promoting research visits of Korean and Swedish researchers

#### 1.2. Features

- Program Type: Researcher Exchange and Workshops/Seminars Organization

- Eligible Fields : All academic fields

<sup>\*\*</sup> The program is exclusively for workshop/seminars and research visit. Up to 1 year extension of research period is possible, without extra funding.

#### <NOTE>

- 1. Korean researchers can apply only one of the two programs at the same fiscal year.
- 2. In case of NRF-STINT R&D Network Program, applicants of each country should submit proposals to their country's responsible funding agencies (Korean researchers to the NRF / Swedish researchers to STINT). Swedish researchers are encouraged to check STINT for their funding. Plus, only proposals received to both the NRF and STINT are subject to evaluation.
- 3. Applicants of Korea-Nordic R&D Network Program should submit supporting documents to NRF if they are conducting projects supported by those counterpart countries' (Norway, Denmark, Finland) funding agencies.
- 4. The funding above is for Korean researchers applying to NRF. Partner researchers are encouraged to check STINT for their funding.
- 5. Funding grants include indirect expenses (less than 7% of direct expenses).
- 6. The program is aimed at building the network and base for research exchange activities, rather than conducting research itself. Therefore, when counting the costs of research equipment and materials is necessary, the relevance of the use thereof during the research should be specified in the proposal.
- 7. Personnel expense is not provided.
- 8. The full name of partner organizations and researchers, and research titles should be used in application form (in English).
- 9. An applicant should choose out a code (from Classifications of Academic Research Field) which he/she thinks represents his/her research fields (enclosed in Excel file).
- 10. A due date for submission may vary depending on partner organization so the applicant is encouraged to check the period of submission and its results with his/her respective partner organization.

<sup>\*\*</sup> The projects are unilaterally funded by NRF. The project with matching fund from parter organization will be prioritized in selection process.

## 2. Application Guidelines

## 2.1. Eligibility

- Researchers at universities/institutes eligible under Article 2 of the Academic Promotion Act 

  \* Swedish side researchers should meet qualifications by STINT.
- Researchers who are **NOT** restricted under the followings:
  - ① A researcher who has already participated in more than one research under ROK-Nordic R&D Cooperation Program.
- ② A researcher, as of the commencement date, who is currently participating or intends to participate as PI in other NRF funded international cooperation programs\*.
  - \*\*Short-term research exchange (international symposium/seminar/airfare funding) programs are NOT included.

    \*\*For the project with extended period due to COVID-19, only originally contracted period is considered.
- ③ A researcher under restriction of participation in national R&D project (participation can be allowed only if his/her restriction ends before the last day of submission).
- ④ A researcher funded by the NRF, and who has not yet submitted the final report on the respective projects within due date.
- ⑤ A researcher who intends to submit the same research already funded by either the NRF or other funding agencies.



#### <NOTE>

- 1. PI application and organization approval should all be done within application period. Application is not accepted without approval of organization.
- 2. In electronic application, seal or stamp from researcher and lead organization is not required.
- 3. Swedish side applicant should submit their application via STINT website\*.

#### 2.3. Requirements \*Forms for each requirement are enclosed.

- Proposal(either in Korean or English)
- Letter of Collaboration between PIs(Email or official letter)
- Personal Information Collection and Use Consent Form
- (Conditional) Document\* to prove matching fund \* Only for Korea-Nordic Program
- \* Applicant to Korea-Nordic R&D Network Program should submit supporting documents to NRF if they are conducting in projects supported by those counterpart countries' (Norway, Denmark, Finland) funding agencies.

## 3.3 Selection

- Selection is finalized through consultation among funding agency (STINT)
- As stated in [Management Guideline for International Cooperation Program], a project with a score of less than 60 is excluded from the final selection.
- The NRF may not select any projects if they are under-qualified for funding.

# 4. Project Management

- 4.1. Submission of Reports \*\* Forms and other details (how to submit, lengths etc.) will be provided by the NRF
- Mid-term report: Must be submitted to the NRF within one month after the end of the current year
- Final report: Must be submitted to the NRF within one month after the end of project
- Mid-term and final evaluation shall be implemented according to [Management Guideline for International Cooperation Program].

#### 4.2. Management of Research Fund

- Provision: The NRF provides contracted fund to a lead institute after concluding contract.
- Management A lead institute is responsible for management of research funds.
  - \* Funding grants include indirect expenses (less than 7% of direct expenses).
  - \*\* The program is aimed at building the network and base for research exchange activities, rather than conducting research itself. Therefore, when counting the costs of research equipment and materials is necessary, the relevance of the use thereof during the research should be specified in the proposal.
  - \* Personnel expense is not provided.
- Use of Fund: Fund should be used according to the proposal for contract and [Management Guideline for International Cooperation Program].
  - \* Fund must be used by Research Credit Card and be managed through EZbaro System.
- Financial Report (adjustment): Should be reported via Ezbaro system within 3 months after the end of current research year
  - \*\* For multi-year contract, balance may be carried to the next year, yet in the same category.

#### 4.3. Research Outcome and Acknowledgement

- A lead institute (or PI) should register/upload research outcomes to NRF's e-R&D system for five years after the end of the project. The NRF may request a lead institute(or PI) to submit research outcomes in hard copy.
- In any research outcomes (thesis, journal, etc.) acknowledgement should be included.
